Motor Homes: Class A

A Class A Motor Home is identified as:

- Entirely constructed on a specially designed motor vehicle chassis
- Commonly referred to as a conventional Motor Home
- Fully loaded and equipped for short trips, lengthy vacations and full timing
- Size: 21 to 40 feet
- Average Cost: \$81,400 (\$48,000 to over \$300,000)
- Upper end vehicles are commonly referred to as a Motor-Coach or simply, a Coach



Motor Homes: Class B

A Class B Motor Home is identified as:

- A cargo van that has been customized to include temporary sleeping, eating and bathroom facilities
- Commonly referred to as a van camper
- Most economical, versatile and maneuverable of the Motor Homes
- Size: 16 to 21 feet
- Average Cost: \$43,600 (\$33,000 to \$65,000)



Motor Homes: Class C

A Class C Motor Home is identified as:

- Built on a van frame (chassis) with an attached cab section
- Commonly referred to as a mini-Motor Home
- Similar conveniences as the Class A Motor Home, but scaled-down and lower priced
- Size: 20 to 28 feet
- Average Cost: \$48,500 (\$39,000 to \$67,000)



RV Types: Freightliner Tow Vehicles

American Modern insures heavy-duty tow vehicles designed specifically for towing Travel Trailers. Often referred to as Freightliners, as this is a major manufacturer, these can only be written if American Modern insures the both the Travel Trailer as well as the towing vehicle. Two policies would be generated; one for the Freightliner towing vehicle and another for the towed Travel Trailer.
